 VG = Very Good; letters and cancel well imprinted but perhaps some lightness or other defect.
 G = Good; some defect, such as some letters or portion of cancel light or not imprinted, or right ends of lines or bars run off the edge of the card or cover.
 P = Poor; merely an identifiable and countable example.

- VF = Very Fine; attractive, no faults.
 VG = Very Good; minor fault such as toning; not described.
 G = Good; some fault, such as opening reductions; described.
 P = Poor; doggy; faults; described.
